1. Just Don't!

Do everything you can to avoid driving during a hurricane. Group your errands into one drive.

3. Know Your Abilities

No matter what type of vehicle you drive, you are not all powerful. Always drive cautiously.

5. Turn Around

If the road is flooded, you don't know how deep it is. Don't try to drive through high waters.

2. Maintain Safe Distances

If you can't help but drive, be sure to keep a safe distance between your vehicle and the others on the road.

4. Handling a Spin

Don't slam on the brakes or jerk the wheel. Instead, let off the gas and gently steer into the skid to regain control.

6. Flashing Intersections

An intersection that has a malfunctioning light should be treated as a four-way stop. Avoid driving aggressively.
